Neurorehabilitation, or neurological rehabilitation, refers to the medical and therapeutic process of improving an individual's overall skills, functions and wellbeing following a serious injury or neurological condition.

Following a brain or spinal injury, a neurological event such as a stroke, infection or brain tumour, or due to a degenerative condition like multiple sclerosis, an individual can experience enormous changes to their life – from physical and cognitive functioning to emotional and mental health.

AMPUTATION

An amputee is taught with therapy and training on how to cope and resume their functional activities. The process aims at restoring independence to the individual to the highest possible level, allowing them to carry out as many normal activities as possible and improve their quality of life.



BRAIN INJURY

A brain injury can be classed in several ways, ranging from mild and temporary to catastrophic and permanent. However, no matter how a traumatic or acquired brain injury is categorised, it is always likely to cause some level of impairment to an individual.



BRACHIAL PLEXUS INJURY

With a brachial plexus injury, sensory and motor function of the arm may be completely or partially impaired and the patient often experiences severe neuropathic. pain. Symptoms can range in severity and can vary from being mild numbness in the limb or electric shock-like sensations in the arm.



CEREBRAL PALSY

Cerebral palsy is an umbrella term for a group of non-progressive and permanent neurological conditions. Legal teams and case managers supporting families and children living with cerebral palsy should be aware of the significant impact which affects multiple skills.



COMPLEX NEUROLOGICAL DISABILITY

Complex neurological disabilities are associated with underlying chronic conditions such as multiple sclerosis, spina bifida, Guillain–Barré syndrome (GBS), Parkinson's diseases and motor neurone disease.




GUILLAIN-BARRÉ SYNDROME

Guillain–Barré syndrome (GBS) is a medical condition where an individual experiences symptoms of muscle weakness that are rapid in onset and frequently severe.



HYPOXIC BRAIN INJURY

Cerebral hypoxia or anoxia occurs when there is a break in the continuous supply of oxygen to the brain. This cut-off of oxygen leaves the brain unable to maintain its normal physiological functions that control almost all the processes going on inside the human body.



MUSCULOSKELETAL INJURY

Musculoskeletal injuries can result in difficulty in movement and pain so rehabilitation programs are focused on improving the patient's ability to function, reduction in their symptoms, and raise their overall standards of health.



SPINAL CORD INJURY

Recovery and rehabilitation following a spinal cord injury can be a long and difficult process. Solicitors representing clients with spinal cord injury should be guided by the experts throughout this complex series of therapeutic interventions.



STROKE REHABILITATION

Following a stroke, many individuals require support to regain as much independence as possible and improve the quality of their life. The aim of neurorehabilitation following a stroke is for individuals to relearn the skills that were lost due to damage this causes.




The Consultant carries out an expert clinical assessment, developing a Specialist Rehabilitation Prescription to provide a framework for the MDT.

THE REHABILITATION PRESCRIPTION

In 2010, the NHS Clinical Advisory Group for Trauma recommended that every patient with major trauma should receive high-quality rehabilitation.

When being discharged, all patients who require rehabilitation should 'have their rehabilitation needs assessed and documented through a Rehabilitation Prescription.'

The Rehabilitation Prescription gives clients, and everyone involved in their care, a comprehensive overview of immediate and longer-term neurorehabilitation requirements.

It acts as a guide to navigating the complexity of neurological disability.

As part of the NRC Clinical Practice service, our expert Consultants provide a Specialist Rehabilitation Prescription for every client. We consider this a crucial blueprint to maximise recovery potential.

There are two types of Rehabilitation Prescription:

- The Standard Rehabilitation Prescription, designed for patients with lower-level rehabilitation requirements
- The Specialist Rehabilitation Prescription, for patients with complex needs.

The Specialist Rehabilitation Prescription applies to patients who initially require Level 1 & 2 inpatient rehabilitation with highly specialist multi-disciplinary input.

It can only be completed by a Consultant in Rehabilitation Medicine and comes as standard with NRC Clinical Practice.

NRC Consultants ensure the Specialist Rehabilitation Prescription works as it should to deliver the promise of rehabilitation. This regular expert oversight ensures the actions detailed in the Specialist Rehabilitation Prescription have been implemented.
